Against the backdrop of anthropogenic climate change and other environmental concerns, the discourse in this edited volume' emerges from the recognition that corporations around the globe are on an entirely unsustainable trajectory. The book identifies some existing mechanisms as partial solutions to the problem, as well as current barriers in motivating corporate sustainability for the future. It is true to say that the book, for the most part, does not leave the reader wanting in this regard. This is especially important and indeed central to the success of the volume, given the universality of environmental concerns. It is particularly refreshing that jurisdictions, as well as considerable expertise as a collective as, in this volume, the editors have brought together a compelling selection of eight thought-provoking chapters with commentary across the UK, the USA, Canada, New Zealand, Australia, Norvay and Finland, as well as the rest of continental Europe, amongst others.

This is not the book for a reader looking for an in-depth discussion of black letter environmental or corporate law, or some hybrid of the two.
