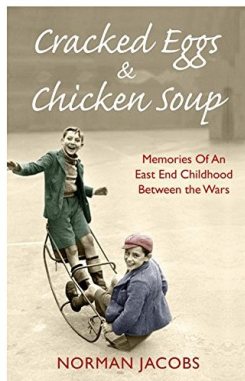


Growing Up Between the Wars

Since war broke out in Syria almost six years ago, a whole generation of children is growing up in wartime. We document the association between war-related shocks in childhood and adult outcomes for Europeans born during the first half of the twentieth century.
